**TRANSFORMING GEORGIA STATE LAW:** The college broke ground in September on a seven-story building off Atlanta’s famed Peachtree Street that will facilitate increased **student to faculty interaction** and **external outreach**. The new building is designed to support the **programmatic demands of 21st-century legal instruction**, including **flexible classrooms**, a **skills suite** and **firm-style clinical offices** to expand **experiential opportunities**.
